Dr Christopher Philip Aldren, UK

Consultant Adult & Paediatric Ear, Nose and Throat Surgeon

MB BS MA FRCS FRCS(ORL)

- Chris Aldren is an adult and paediatric ENT surgeon based in Windsor. He is internationally known as an expert ear surgeon and has a particular interest in stapedectomy for otosclerosis and ossiculoplasty for hearing restoration.
- Chris did his undergraduate medical training at Gonville and Caius College, Cambridge University and then at The Royal London Hospital.
- His early ENT training was at The Royal National Throat, Nose and Ear Hospital and The Royal Marsden Hospital both in London.
- He then trained in Newcastle and Brisbane, Australia where he was a visiting fellow.
- He was appointed consultant at Wexham Park Hospital in 1997 where he has developed his interest in ear surgery.
- Chris sees patients with all ENT conditions but has a specialist interest in hearing restoration for both adults and children with surgery ranging from grommets to more complex cases. He has particularly expertise in the treatment of otosclerosis, cholesteatoma and other causes of hearing loss.

- Chris runs a highly rated international course in ear surgery at Wexham Park each year since 2000.
- He is in great demand as a speaker throughout the world with recent lectures in France, Slovakia, Hungary, The Netherlands, Spain, Saudi Arabia, India and Brazil. He also travels demonstrating live surgery.
- In 2010 he was the invited surgeon for the Indian Society of Otolaryngology annual meeting where he demonstrated live surgery for 1000 ear surgeons. For 4 years he transmitted his surgery live every week to students in the Netherlands.
- He is the immediate past President of LION, the Live International Otolaryngology Network. This is a grouping of the world's leading ear surgeons, who transmit their surgery live via the internet to teach other surgeons and inform the general public. Access is open to everyone for free at www.lion-web.org.
- Chris is the President Elect of the Royal Society of Medicine Section of Otolaryngology.
- He was the President of the British Society of Otolaryngology from 2016 to 2018.
- He is the immediate past President of LION the Live International Otolaryngology Network www.lion-web.org, which is a grouping of the world's leading ear surgeons. He has been operating on the network and moderating their international meetings from Utrecht since 2008.
- He was the academic secretary for BACO 2009 (British Academic Conference in Otolaryngology) the biggest UK meeting in ENT and has organised their otology programme for the 2018 meeting.
- He is the UK representative for CEORL_HNS (The Confederation of Otorhinolaryngological and Head and Neck Surgical Societies) and the new editor of the otology section of Scott Brown's textbook of Otolaryngology.
- Chris is a member of the European Academy of Otolaryngology and gives an instructional lecture on otosclerosis and stapedotomy at their biannual meetings.
- In 2014 he organised the first British Scandinavian Otolaryngology meeting in Windsor.
- In 2018 he will lecture in France, Switzerland, Poland, Sweden and India.
- Chris is involved in research and audit in all areas of ENT and helped develop an international ear surgery database www.ondb.org. He is currently helping to write European guidelines on stapedectomy and the management of otosclerosis for the European Academy of Otolaryngology and Neurotology.
- Outside of medicine Chris has 3 professional musician children and is a keen violinist playing in the European Doctors Orchestra. He is on the advisory council of the London Philharmonic Orchestra.

Dr Vinidh Paleri MS FRCS (ORL-HNS), UK

*Consultant Head and Neck Surgeon, The Newcastle upon Tyne Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust
Honorary Professor of Head and Neck Surgery, Newcastle University*

My clinical practice is almost entirely devoted to benign and malignant diseases of the head and neck. I am one of the few surgeons in the United Kingdom with expertise in Transoral Robotic Surgery and Transoral Laser Microsurgery for head and neck cancers. I have accrued the largest experience in transoral robotic surgery in the UK.

My research interests are primarily on the processes of care, decision making and functional outcomes in head and neck oncology. I have published over 170 papers, reviews and book chapters on head and neck oncology. I am chief investigator for the NIHR funded TUBE trial and contribute as co-investigator and principal investigator for several other national trials. Currently, I serve as Chairman of the research council for the British Association of Head and Neck Oncologists, and as member of the following national bodies: Head and Neck Cancer Clinical Studies Group of the National Cancer Research Institute, the Interventional Procedures Panel of the National Institute for Health Research and the ENT-UK Head & Neck Society and the Guidelines committee for the 2016 National Institute for Health and Care Excellence guidelines on Upper aerodigestive tract cancer. I have co-edited the fourth and fifth editions of the UK National Head and Neck Cancer Multidisciplinary Management Guidelines, and also co-edit the section on "Head and Neck Disease" for the forthcoming 8th edition of Scott-Brown's Otolaryngology, the leading multi-volume multi-author textbook in the specialty in the world, planned for publication in July 2018. I am an Associate Editor for Head and Neck, the top ranked journal in the field, Senior Reviews Editor for the Journal of Laryngology and Otolaryngology, one of the oldest journals in the field (est. 1887) and serve on the editorial board for the Annals of Otolaryngology, Rhinology & Laryngology.

Dr Satish Jain

Dr. Satish Jain has done Master degree in ENT from SMS Medical College in 1999. He has to his credit Gold medal award in the Quiz Competition in AOICON in 1998. He was awarded Gold medal in the paper competition in 1998 in Rajasthan AOICON.

After Post graduation he had training in Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai & Dr. ABR Desai's Centre in Mumbai. He owns the largest ENT centre in the private sector in the country. He has a vast experience of ENT, Head & Neck and Skull base surgery and has done over 50,000 surgeries in this field.

He has been invited as a guest faculty in International Live Surgical Workshop in the Singapore General Hospital 4 times. He has given live surgical demonstration, lectures on various topics on endoscopic sinus surgery and endoscopic anterior skull base surgery. Besides this he has organized Instructional Courses of Cadaveric Dissection on Endonasal Anterior Skull base surgery.

He has been invited as a guest faculty for live surgical demonstration by University of Leipzig (Germany) in 2012. He performed live surgeries on Lateral Skull Base, delivered oration and conducted Instructional Course on lateral skull base surgery. He has been rewarded as Honorary Master Surgical expert since then by University of Leipzig, invited as guest faculty in various other countries including Indonesia, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Turkey, Dubai etc.

In India, he has been invited for live surgical demonstration & orations by various state conferences including Karnataka, Delhi, Gujarat, Haryana, Punjab, UP etc and AOICON at Allahabad.

He has been invited by various National & International Otolaryngology forums for endoscopic anterior skull base Cadaver dissection demonstration and Microscopic lateral skull base demonstration.

He has given live surgical demonstrations in various neurosurgical forums of Endonasal Endoscopic anterior skull base surgeries with this he has organized more than 25 conferences and workshops at his centre in Jaipur on various subjects in Otolaryngology, Head – Neck & Skull base surgeries.

He has organized 10 hands on live surgical courses in otolaryngology at his centre in Jaipur wherein participants operated under Individual Master's guidance and so far over 500 young ENT surgeons have been benefitted through these courses.

His centre has been regularly visited by young ENT surgeons from various countries for focused training in various subjects for duration of one to two months and introduced various newer surgical techniques in ENT surgeons including modifications of Interlay Tympanoplasty and Intact canal wall Masteoidectomy techniques, convergent approach to identification of facial nerve in Parotid surgery, common Cavity skeletonization technique in endoscopic sinus surgery etc.

Apart from his professional responsibility he has been deeply involved in social service to the people of poor socio-economical segment living in far rural areas by organizing free awareness & surgical Camps through his team of doctors. He has done so far over 10,000 free surgeries to the poor people and treated over 2.5 lacks patients absolutely free of cost. He is associated with Bhagwan Mahavir Viklang Sahayata Samiti through which he has benefitted over 5000 patients by providing hearing aids to needy patients free of cost.

He leads the training and research division Karl Storz Asia pacific region, demonstrating ventral skull base surgical procedures (for pituitary tumours, craniopharyngiomas, chordomas, tumours of the petrous apex & clivus). We at Royal Pearl Hospital use a 360-degree integrative and multidisciplinary team approach to patients' courage to triumph over the most devastating conditions that inspires us to continue to unearth solutions for the most critical skull base lesions.

As a part of endeavors for continuous innovations and upgradations, we are now proud to announce the commencement of "Lateral skull base surgery" program. This program will accommodate surgeries for diseases like acoustic neuroma, glomus jugulare, jugular foramen lesions, carotid body tumours and tumours of petrous apex.

We are now on the verge of releasing a book, a first of its kind, on juvenile nasopharyngeal angiofibroma. This was achievable because of our patients, catered from all parts of India and abroad.
